

EQUESTRIAN

EQUESTRIAN GENERAL RULES, REGULATIONS, ENTRIES & FEES AS WELL AS DANNEVIRKE & DISTRICTS A&P ASSOCIATION BY-LAWS AND REGULATIONS

The show will be conducted under the Rules and Regulations issued by the Royal Agricultural Society of New Zealand (Inc) for the governance of the Dannevirke District Agricultural and Pastoral Association (Inc.).

HEALTH AND SAFETY

- Each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times, and shall be liable for any hazards created, or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the showgrounds.
- Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate animal legislation and the Health and Safety, in Employment Act 2015.
- Bikes, motorbikes, e-bikes etc are allowed in truck parking areas only. **Helmets must be worn at all times** when riding a bike.
- All competitors riding horses or ponies must wear a riding helmet that has a current **yellow tag**.
- **GR 8. FALL OF RIDER** If a rider has a fall or suspected head injury, at any time at a RAS affiliated Show/Event in the: competition ring/arena, practice/warmup/collecting ring/arena; or elsewhere within the grounds of where the show/event is being convened, the rider must be removed from the activity and checked by the show's nominated First Aid service/personnel and be given the 'all-clear' before the rider is permitted to re-mount and continue riding at the show/event.
- Competitors and members of the public enter the grounds at their own risk.



CLEAN SPORT

Clean Sport rules of the Royal Agriculture Society apply, a copy of which is held in the office or the RAS website www.ras.org.nz. Competitors are advised that there may be random tests for forbidden substances. Any competitor who has administered to his/her horse or pony any forbidden substance during the 7 days prior to the show, is required to notify the Equestrian Secretary before competing. The administering of any drug which affects the performance of a horse or pony is forbidden. The Committee reserves the right to submit any animal to veterinary examination.

ENTRIES

- Enter online at www.main-events.com
- If there are insufficient entries, a class may be cancelled.
- The committee has the right to refuse an entry without explanation. If the number of entries warrant it, a class may be split.
- Competitors to keep own list of classes entered.
- Times in the Catalogue may differ from the Schedule depending upon Entries.
- **Ground levy: \$10.00** per Horse/Pony for the entirety of the Show: The Ground Levy must be paid by all competitors or entries will not be accepted.
- All fees can be paid online to 06-0613-0041542-02. Please include your details
- Entries close 23 January 2026: Late entries will be accepted until 28 January 2026 with a 50% penalty.
- All late entries and changes are to be done through Main-Events messaging under the show.
- **Anyone with an outstanding balance will not be allowed to compete, including outstanding fees from the 2025 show.**

ENTRIES DURING THE SHOW

Competitors will be able to place additional entries during the Show. This will apply only to animals that are already entered/competing at the Show. Additional entries will carry a 50% surcharge on the entry fee, which must be paid at the time the additional entry is made. These entries will then be processed, and updated sheets produced for Stewards for the next day's competition.

TRANSFERS

Competitors may transfer entered horse/pony to a different class under the following conditions:

- Transfers must be done at the Secretary's office or online with Main-Events with any difference in entry fees paid before the start of the class.
- If transferring to a class with a lower entry fee, the difference will be forfeited by the competitor
- **No transfers will be accepted until paid in full.**

SCRATCHINGS & REFUND OF ENTRY FEES

75% of entry fees only for the individual class will be refunded if notified by 5 pm 28 January 2026. Scratchings from the entire show will receive a 75% refund of total entry only if accompanied by a Doctor/Vet/Farrier certificate, this must be received within 7 days of the show.

PRIZE MONEY/REFUNDS

All entry fees & prize money are GST inclusive.

- Prize money and refunds \$10.00 and over will be paid out by direct credit using details on entry form after the show.
- When paying entry fees by direct credit please ensure that your bank account details are included on your official entry form otherwise prize money and refunds cannot be paid.
- For Series Classes, this show will not pay prize money where riders incur 12 faults or more in the first round.



ACCOMMODATION & CAMPING

Competitor camping is free of charge

Open yard: \$20 (whole show)

Covered yards & boxes/stables: \$35 (whole show)

- Yards & boxes will not be allocated until paid for
- Please note on entry form if horse/pony is a stallion, or any other special requirements.
- Horse accommodation cannot be guaranteed to competitors who enter the official close of entries.
- **Any stable/box/yard found to be in an unacceptable state at the conclusion of show will incur an additional \$50 cleaning fee.**

ADDITIONAL NOTICES

- All competitors will receive a receipt of entries plus emailed gate passes for the show; it is your responsibility to have them with you.
- Please note that this is an A&P Show. There will be other livestock present in/near the Oval, and horse classes will continue to run.
- Truck parking: As truck parking space is limited all trucks staying on the grounds must park as advised, close together and with **no tying up of horses at trucks** please tack up in your yard.
- A bar will be operating all weekend from the members tent.
- The committee reserves the right to make any alterations to the show timetable or to postpone/cancel the show or withdraw any event as may be deemed desirable.

Jumping Horse or Pony Registration Options:

- NOT registered with ESNZ at all → Pay \$30.15 Flexi-Start (includes \$25 fee + \$5.15 admin).
- Registered with ESNZ (but not for Jumping/Show Hunter) → Pay \$25 Flexi-Start.
- Registered for Jumping/Show Hunter with ESNZ → No Flexi-Start fee needed.

Note: Horses can only jump up to 1.10m and ponies up to 1.00m on a Flexi-Start. These horses/ponies cannot enter Series Classes or earn HOY points in Show Hunter.

Jumping Rider Membership Options:

- Casual Rider Membership → \$16.30 per event.
- Introductory Membership or Day Start → \$16.30 per day (for INTRO classes only).

Jumping Intro/Day Start Riders may only compete in:

- 80cm and under (Ponies)
- 90cm and under (Horses)

Riders must upgrade to Full ESNZ Membership to enter higher classes or Series classes. Results are not recorded with ESNZ for Intro/Day Start entries.

TROPHIES

- A novice horse/pony/rider is one that has not yet had five wins in total in open and or novice classes in any division within the competitions provided at any A&P Show. - Any horse or pony that misbehaves to the extent that it unduly disturbs other competitors must leave the ring if asked to do so.
- Rings will not be held to wait for riders who are on other mounts.
- Novice ponies may be ridden by an adult.
- Please note times given for later classes are approximate. If classes are small, start times may be earlier.
- Number Holders to be worn in the Show Ring. Exhibitors provide their own number.
- Morning start time is a hard time.
- **In the event of less than 2 entries, the class will not take place.**

A pleasure mount is not an inexperienced mount with show quality, conformation, who is destined for the open show ring. This section is aimed at competitive pleasure combinations. This section is run in alignment with the rules and guidelines of the NZ Equestrian Pleasure Society (NZEPS). To see more information about what type of horse a pleasure horse is and what the NZ Equestrian Pleasure Horse Society is all about go to the website.

RULES:

If you enter this section you may not enter any other RAS Showing (excluding breed classes where competitors may compete) or the RECREATIONAL PLEASURE section at the Show. You can still enter show jumping and show hunter classes at the Show if you are ESNZ registered. Simple snaffles only and no strapping below the bit, i.e. flash straps or drop nosebands. No spurs. Crops/whips allowed but not exceeding 76cm (i.e. No dressage whips) Yellow tagged compliant helmets are compulsory. Plaiting and jackets are optional but preferred. Rider 16 years old and under only in the pony classes, but riders 17 years and over may ride ponies in the horse classes.
